On their first European tour, Australian 's **Elektra Inner Voices** will premiere two new works by composer /violinist Romano Crivici.

A powerful voice in Australian music making, Sydney-based Elektra Inner Voices came into being in the 1990s in response to its members strongly felt need to go beyond the conventional limits, images and accepted boundaries of the traditional string quartet. Under artistic director Romano Crivici, they have developed a new and accessible approach to music making.

**Reflections on Life, Death and Transience** for violin, viola and poet is a lyrical, ambient and at times, intensely emotional work that creates a sacred space in which to reflect on meaning, emotion, death and the transience of life.

**Slavic Grooves and Meditations** scored for flute, violin and viola, is both a joyous and melancholy work that explores distant memories expressed through the melodies and rhythms from Romano's childhood.

They will be performing Reflections on Life, Death and Transience on the **10<sup>th</sup> June, 2014**; and excerpts from Reflections as well as Slavic Grooves and Meditations on the **11<sup>th</sup> June, 2014-06-03** Both concerts will be at **Mundolingua** , 10 Rue Servandoni – 75006, Paris, starting at 8pm.
