Musical Elements:

 - Vln. I:** Starts with *sul pont.*, followed by *normale* and *sul pont.* with *ff*.
 - Vln. II:** Starts with *sul pont.*
 - Vla.:** Starts with *arco* and *normale*.
 - Vc.:** Starts with *sul A*.
- System 2 (Measure 12):**
 - Vln. I:** *divisi normale* and *normale*.
 - Vln. II:** *normale*.
 - Cb.:** *pp sul A*.
